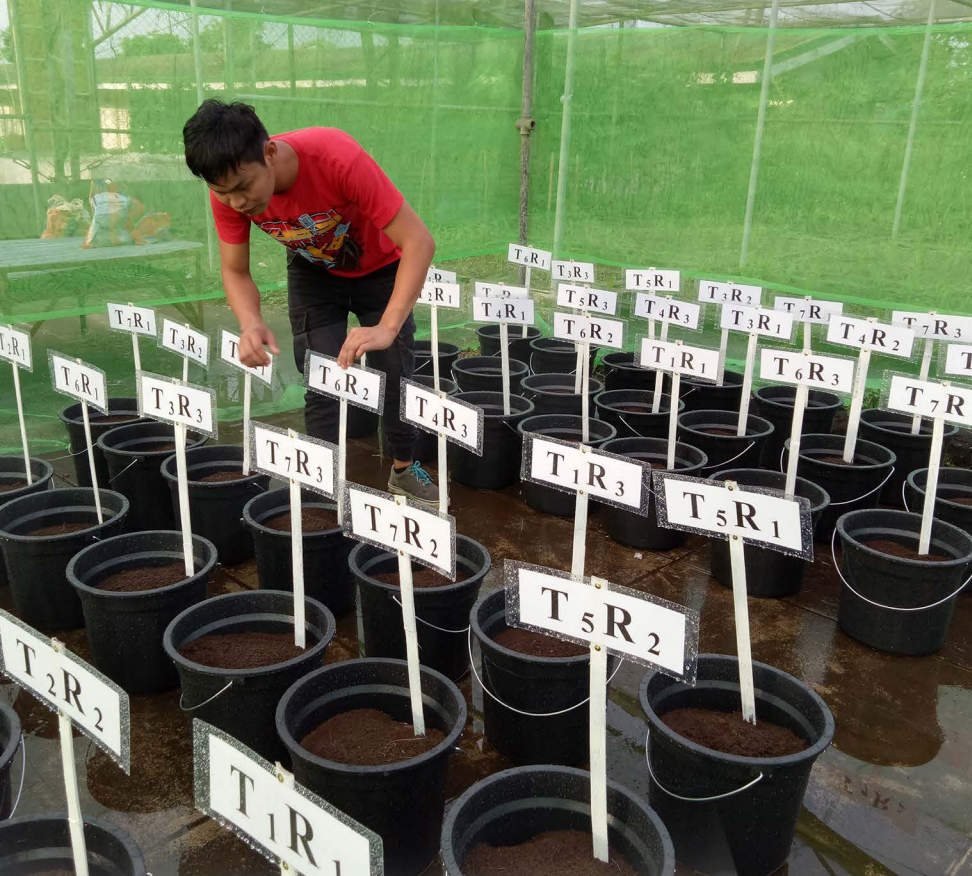

General Eligibility:

- Open to all nationals of all SEAMEO member countries who are regular employees of academic or research institutions or government agencies;
- Not more than 35 (Master's Degree) or 40 (PhD) years of age at the time of application;
- Proposed thesis research should align with SEARCA's overarching theme of Accelerating Transformation Through Agricultural Innovation (ATTAIN)
- Ongoing students from the study posts may apply



DAAD In-Country/In-Region Scholarship Programme Southeast Asia

- Open to all nationals of Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Timor Leste, Thailand, and Vietnam who are employees of academic or research institutions or government agencies (priority is given to regular employees);
- Must have completed their last university degree not more than 6 years ago at the time of application;

Tokyo University of Agriculture-SEARCA Scholarship for Dissertation Doctorate Program

- Must be a researcher with full time employment at the university or research institution;
- Holder of a master's degree in agriculture or related fields;
- Has produced at least three (3) peer-reviewed scientific papers in scholarly journals in applicant's country or abroad and has served first author of at least one of those papers;
- Must have already made a substantial progress in a research project which will deserve a doctorate degree in three years; and
- Not more than 48 years of age at the start of the program.
